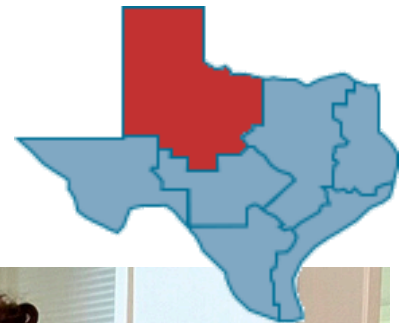

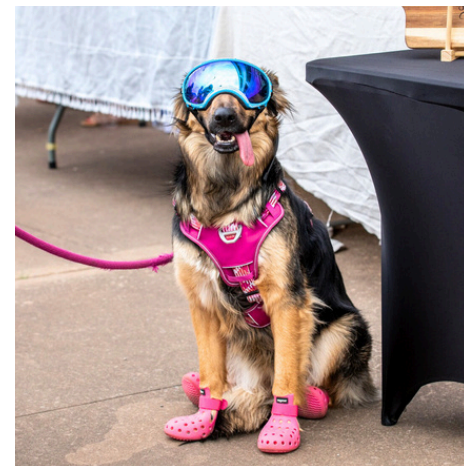
INCENTIVES
